**What?** An eight-week online course scholarship on English as a Medium of Instruction with Ohio University

**For whom?** University professors delivering their disciplinary courses in English (professors of engineering, sociology, math, etc.)

**When?** August 23-November 23 (Orientation week: August 23-September 17)

**How much work?** The course takes place in English and generally requires 8-10 hours of work/week. The professors are in an international cohort with participants from around the world. This course with Ohio University was piloted in Brazil in 2019 with four universities (UFMG, PUC-RS, Unisinos, and UDESC) and participants were successful and positive about their learning.
